



First Aid-1 day Appointed Person

What is ***adequate and appropriate*** will depend on the circumstances in your work place, and you should arrange for an assessment of your First Aid needs and Training Requirements.

The Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1982 requires you to provide adequate and appropriate equipment, facilities and personnel to enable first aid to be given to your employees if they are injured or fall ill at work. It is also important to remember that accidents can happen at any time. **First Aid provision must be available at *all times people are at work*.**

This is a Health & Safety Executive (NI) approved four-day course that complies with the HSE (NI), regarding the provision of First Aid in the Workplace as a legal requirement.

4. Principles of Resuscitation (New protocols)
5. Breathing disorders and disorders of the respiratory system
6. Disorders of the circulation system
7. Control of bleeding and treatment of Shock
8. Bones, Joints and muscle injuries
9. Burns
